Dear Parents/Guardians of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:

The SAT will be administered at the Plainfield Academy of the Arts & Advanced Studies on the March 3, 2021 *SAT School Day* at 8:00am.

This test is only offered on-campus (in-person). Students should arrive no later than 7:45am – as they will not be allowed to enter the test area once testing has begun. ***Students will need to report on time and be picked up by the anticipated completion time of 12noon.*** All students will be required to follow safety and social distancing protocols while participating on campus. These safety procedures include wearing facemasks at all times -before, during and after testing. Students are also expected to bring their own personal materials required for testing; those materials include #2 pencils and a scientific or graphing calculator.

The SAT is a globally recognized college admission test that is accepted at all U.S. colleges. The SAT measures the reading, writing, and math skills that students are learning in high school. It allows students the opportunity to demonstrate that they have the knowledge required to succeed in college and/or career choices. The following are other key benefits of participating in the SAT School Day:

- Testing on a school day usually does not interfere with weekend work or family obligations.
- Students test in a familiar location with staff they know, which may reduce anxiety associated with testing.
- Students who have been struggling academically are provided with another opportunity to prove their college readiness to universities.

Additionally, students can also meet New Jersey graduation requirements if reading and math proficiency scores are achieved.
